This year these included: Dance, Cricket, Fencing, Indoor Athletics, Taekwondo. These have been shared between Years 1 – 6. Level 2 (inter-school) competitions and festivals, linked to 'taster' sessions. Free/reduced cost Professional Development opportunities for staff to develop their own curriculum knowledge, planning and delivery. Support to deliver the national agenda, e.g. Change 4 Life Clubs, School Sports Organising Crews, School games award. Participation in Olympic Values awards ceremony. Participation in Bronze ambassador programme. Participation in Y2 and Y4 sports festival.
