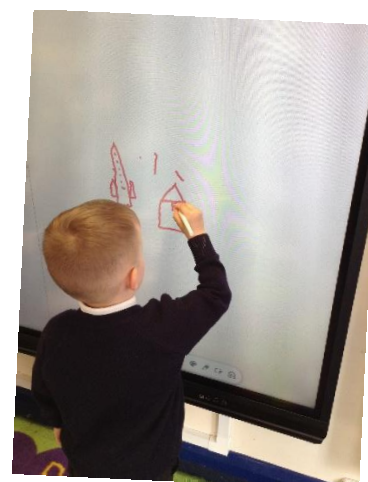


St Andrew's Newsletter
