I cannot express enough how important it is for children to be in school.

At St. Andrew's we all want to work with families to support them in bringing their children to school as much as possible. Please do speak to your child's class teacher if you need to make them aware of any particular difficulties you are facing with getting your children to school on time, or about any medical concerns about your children.

For all appointments booked during school time we require proof so that we can authorise the absence. Where possible, appointments should be made after 3:30 and during school holidays.
