Parent Questionnaires

Thank you for returning the questionnaires. Next week I will publish the analysis of the feedback from parents. I will also reveal which class completed the most (as a percentage of the whole class due to different class sizes) and which family won the lucky prize.

Attendance

Our whole school attendance for February was 94.5%. Of this 4.2% was authorised absence and 1.3% unauthorised.

The class with the highest attendance was Year 6 with 97.7%. They have earned a non-uniform day to be taken at a time agreed with Mr Astill. Well done!

The percentages for each class for February are:

Reception = 94.3% Year 1 = 92.2% Year 2 = 93.9% Year 3 = 92.1% Year 4 = 96.9% Year 5 = 95.3% Year 6 = 97.7%

We are now operating a slightly different system of monitoring attendance. The first step is that we send letters out to all those with less than 90% attendance to offer a meeting and to advise parents of the need to ensure good attendance for their child. The second step is that if, after a month, there is no significant improvement in their child' attendance, a letter is sent requesting a meeting with me to discuss attendance. The final step is the referral to the Participation Team. This will happen if parents do not attend the meeting with me or their child's attendance does not improve significantly.
