The monies raised provide the children throughout the school with equipment and other items the school would not be able to afford.

Every child in the school receives a Christmas present. Year 6 also get leavers' pens, memory books and for the Isle of White trip we provide caps.

Over the years we have bought climbing frames for both infants and juniors, benches, sheds, nursery items, bikes, sand trays etc. Generally the school uses the monies to help with items giving the children new experiences and extra activities that would not normally happen.
