Communication and Language

We are listening to stories related to the theme Under the sea. Some of the books we will read are Hooray for fish! Rainbow fish, Billy's bucket and Commotion in the ocean.

We are beginning to understand 'why' and 'how' questions.

We are learning vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to us.

Personal, Social and **Emotional Development**

We are enjoying the responsibility of carrying out small tasks independently.

We are initiating play by, talking and interacting with our peers, offering cues for them to join in.

We are learning how to be patient and wait our turn.

Physical Development

We will be exploring different ways of moving.

We are learning about giving meaning to the marks we make, e.g. this is a house, this is my mum.


We will be using some of our print and letter knowledge in our early writing.
