Writing

Understand and use the features of a persuasive letter and a story that contains a mystery. Focus on using linking ideas across paragraphs using adverbials of time, relative clauses, use of commas to clarify meaning or avoid ambiguity, converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes.

Reading
