YEAR: 1

ENGLISH	We will continue to explore a range of sounds in phase 4 and 5 phonics. We will continue with spelling lists and two guided reading sessions per week. The children will be reading traditional tales and writing their own stories as well as reading and reciting traditional rhymes in poetry.	MUSIC	Fast and Slow - tempo within different pieces of music will be explored and compared. Children will also listen to, and discuss stories told through music. Exploring timbre and dynamics of music. Exploring instruments and symbols.
MATHS	The children will develop their reasoning about shapes and problem solving using measures and money. They will develop mental calculations and explain their mathematical strategies. They will begin to partition numbers into tens and units and continue to practise written recording of calculations.	RELIGIOUS EDUCATION	The children will be looking at journeys, dreams, pilgrimage and baptism.
SCIENCE	The children will be learning about seasons. They will be learning about the Sun and Earth and describing the different types of weather for each season. The children will also be learning about seasons.	PE	Athletics will be the main focus of the term. The children will develop their skills in travelling with a ball, throwing, catching in various game situations, running and jumping. The children will also be learning skills in football on a Monday, taught by a specialist coach.
HISTORY	Children will be learning about homes from the past and how they have changed throughout history.	PSHE	The children will be working on ways to solve problems and how to look after each other. Children will develop an understanding of how their thoughts, feelings and behaviour are linked.
GEOGRAPHY	The children will be learning about the four countries in the UK and capital cities around the world.	DESIGN TECHNOLOGY	The children will develop their skills of design, review and evaluation through building cardboard houses.
ART	Children will be creating collages using a combination of materials that are cut, torn and glued. They will mix materials to create texture.	COMPUTING	The children will learn how to follow instructions to make something happen and have an awareness of how information is presented in the world around us. They will use simple publishing software.
