<b>ENGLISH</b>	Text work will focus on identifying features of stories with imaginary settings such as <i>Where the Wild things are</i> . Sentence work will reinforce full stops, capitals and use of different vocabulary. In Letters and Sounds we will be covering Phase 4 and 5.	<b>MUSIC</b>	Music work will relate to body percussion, composing pieces and developing a range of sounds. Children will identify and discuss the sense of mood within pieces of music.
<b>MATHS</b>	Number work will focus on counting back from 100 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, as well as adding and subtracting numbers mentally. We will also extend understanding of money, shape, measure and problem solving.	<b>RELIGIOUS EDUCATION</b>	The Bible; religious symbols and their meaning; Holy Communion and healing. Lent and Easter will also be studied.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Children will compare and discuss the structure of different animals. They will identify and name a variety of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Children will be introduced to the idea of plants as living things. They will learn about the similarities and differences in plants. They will name common wild plants and investigate what plants need to grow.	<b>PE</b>	<u>Football</u> – Children will learn skills in football through games.  <u>Gymnastics</u> : Children will explore travelling on and off the apparatus. They will use different body parts to take their weight and develop balance and control when travelling.
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	Children will draw and sketch a variety of maps. They will learn how to interpret maps of their classroom and playground.  Children will look at the different places people live. They will find out about types of settlements such as villages, towns, urban and rural areas.	<b>PSHE</b>	<u>Living long, living strong</u> : Children will learn about how to stay healthy.  <u>Daring to be different</u> : Children will acknowledge their strengths and the strengths of others. They will gain an understanding of being proud and learn strategies to stay calm in a stressful situation.
<b>ART/DT</b>	Collage and printing will be explored. Children will look at the work of Andy Warhol and use his techniques in their own art work. Children will be introduced to the concept of weaving.	<b>COMPUTING</b>	Children will develop their skills and understanding in coding. They will understand what algorithms are and be able to create a sequence of instructions on the coding programme to create a moving picture. Children will continue to use technology safely and respectfully.
