ENGLISH	Using the context of UFOs, children explore recounts investigating genuine documents, discussing famous sightings and researching notorious hoaxes (UFOs and Aliens: Investigating Extra-terrestrial Visitors - Extreme! by Paul Mason, UFO Diary by Satoshi Kitamura). Children write a diary entry and create their own hoax UFO photo and report.	MUSIC	Rounds – exploring 2 part singing and playing together. Space theme – using clusters of closely pitched notes of different rhythms.
MATHS	Place value, addition and subtraction, place value and addition, co-ordinates and line graphs, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals, perimeter, area and volume.	RELIGIOUS EDUCATION	Easter – Lent Religious festivals. Learning about and from Hindu, Muslim and Jewish festivals.
SCIENCE	Earth and Space – spherical bodies, super sizes, night and time zones, day data, what is a year? A lunar month. Life cycles – seed dispersal, germination. Pollination, parts of a flower.	PE	Swimming (all term). Spring 1 – Judo with Mr. Jones. Work on agility, reaction. Response, co-ordination, ball handling and balance. Work on shape, space and movement.
HISTORY	Not a focus this term	PSHE	Living Long, Living Strong – wellbeing, leadership, effective learning. Daring to be different. Different opinion, agreeing and disagreeing and choices.
GEOGRAPHY	Water Uses of water and our local area. How does water get to where it is needed? How is our local area changing?	TECHNOLOGY	Not a focus this half term
