Home Sweet Home (Short Film); *Tuesday* by David Wisner; Haikus, Tankas and Cinquains

Reading

Wind & Water Power; Coal; *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* by C.S.Lewis. Reading comprehension: texts focusing on a VIPERS skill each week: vocabulary, inference, predict, explain, retrieve, summarise

Writing

Narrative writing applying description and detail using descriptive vocabulary; create dialogue between characters using direct speech; report; recount; alternative endings; poetry

Maths:Decimals

Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundreds; recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$; compare numbers up to 2 decimal places.

Money

Write money using decimals; convert between pounds and pence; compare, estimate and calculate with money.

Time

Convert between analogue and digital times; convert to and from the 24 hour clock.

RE:How do Hindu's worship?

Learn that Hindus worship one Supreme Being called Brahman; that images of gods and goddesses represent different attributes of Brahman; that many Hindus begin prayers with the Aum sound, believed to be the first sound of creation; that many Hindus worship both at home shrines and at a mandir; that the River Ganges is an important pilgrimage site in India.
